The meeting was therefore organized on 29.11.2023 and Fr. Dr. Donatus Kujur, the Principal and Chairperson of the Library Committee, presided over the meeting. The meeting was attended by all the Committee Members. Followings were the minutes of that meeting:

Minutes of Library Committee Meeting, St. Joseph's College, 29.11.2023.

- 1. For Data Entry in Koha Software, College will pass one work order for outsourcing through Libcare & Cure, Tribeni, Hooghly-712503;
- 2. There will be one Library Orientation Programme, especially on Koha, for our college teachers in February, 2024;
- 3. Third Semester Students (who were admitted in 2022) will come under Koha user database;
- 4. There will be arrangement for available E-books to be accessible online;
- 5. There will be arrangement for published research works of our college teachers to develop an Institutional Repository to be accessible online;
- 6. For upgradation college library following decisions were taken:
 - To arrange fire extinguishing system;
 - To make 10 identical racks for the purpose of stacking of journals (18inch X 36inch X 96inch height), of deep green colour. Maker has to come to see the structure and measure.
 - Good and same colored curtains for windows and glass walls;
 - To make required number of wooden map racks;
 - To fix portraits on the walls of two halls;
 - To fix door slowing equipment at the front door;
 - Four computers in small room for data entry in Koha software; and
 - One black ink-tank printer.
- 7. Decision for plagiarism software was not finalized, for which teachermembers will enquire;
- 8. For book purchase, every department other than Bengali Department and Hindi Department, has to utilize Rs.20,000 by 29th February, 2024.

- Data entry for the library books is over;
- The process for SJC's Institutional Repository has been initiated;
- A master list of the links for several types of e-resources (e-documents) has been notified through the SJC teachers' What'sApp group;
- Books are purchased by the departments, as per the allotment of budget;
- One good printer has been procured and added to our library;
- Requirements for book racks are to be revised;
- Implementation processes for the other works are going on.

ACTIVITIES IN LIBRARY, 2023-24. (A) Three Days KOHA Training Programme

For the purpose of library automation and skill development among the library staff of the Central Library (Fr. John Whelan Library) and SFC (Self Finance Courses) Library of St. Joseph's College, an on-site "Three Days Koha Training Programme" (As a part of Library and Staff Development Programmes, with the assistance of Gurudas College, Kolkata-700054) was organized in the college. Besides the programme was essentially a part of cloud based library automation programme through Koha, supported by the Bengal Library Association, Kolkata-700014. It was held during 24-26 August 2023 in the Conference Hall as well as in Central Library of the college.

(B) Library Automation Project

We have newly started data entry in KOHA Software for our whole collection of library books, since January 2024 under the LibCare and Cure (Enterprise), Hooghly-712503. Further to mention that all the books are receiving 6-digit new accession numbers starting from 000001 onwards. All the books will be tagged Call Numbers on the spine newly. Books are now bar-coded with new 6-digit accession numbers as well.
