DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE REPORT (2022-23)

Dr. Samir Sharma, Head of Department

The Department of Political Science is one of the largest Social Science departments in the College. For the academic year of 2022-2023 the total strength of Honours students in the three semesters stood at 226. The department has focused on the balance between its academic and co-curricular commitments for the Undergraduate students resulting in a furry of activities in the Department. The highlight for this academic session has been the Faculty and Student exchanges with two colleges – one in West Bengal and another in Meghalaya – which was definitely enriched the learning capacities of the students. 8. Participation in Annual Survey of Education Report (ASER), 2022






Annual Status of Education Report (ASER) is a nationwide household survey that captures the status of children's enrollment and learning outcomes in rural India every year. The Research and Assessment units design and implement research projects and measurement tools that delve deeper into different aspects of children's educational trajectories. Our students who were 27 in number were part of field studies in different locations such as Badamtam, Sonada, Marybong, Longview, Garidhura, Kolbung, Mahanadi, Peshok, Tindharia and Ghayabari. Outcome of the activity was the development of methodological rigour in conducting field survey and collection of data among the students including team work and peer-learning.

5. Ms. Sharddha Shah






