St. Joseph's College was established in 1927 and the Department of Economics started it's journey at St. Joseph's college from 1970. Shri. Bishal Rai succeeded Dr. Sujoy Kanti Ghoshal as the Head of the Department. Shri Bishal Rai took charge as the Head w.e.f. July 2024. The department has four sanctioned posts. Dr. Panchali Sengupta who was on lien having joined Cooch Behar Panchana Barma University resigned on March 2025. Hence, currently the department has three permanent faculty. Fr. Dr. Sanjiv Lakra also joined the department w.e.f. February 2025 to assist the department amidst his other responsibilities in the institution. Fr. Dr. Sanjiv Lakra. In the first half of the academic session 2024-24, Ms. Anugraha Kalikote served the department as part-time faculty. Furthermore, students also participated in various other co-curricular activities like sports, NSSO, NCC etc. in the academic session 2024-2025. On the whole, the Department of Economics has been functioning with the objective of creating productive youths for the society.

#### **Departmental Activities**

• The academic session 2024-25 commenced on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2024. The orientation for first semester was organized on 29<sup>th</sup> July the in the department from 11:00 a.m. onwards. All the four faculty members (with then part-timer faculty) attended the Orientation Programme. All the faculty members briefed the students about the required information.
