# Career guidance and Counselling

# Spiritual Renewal Program

From November 4-6, 2022, a group of fifty-four students engaged in the Spiritual Renewal Program hosted at Loyola Pastoral Centre in Matigara. It involved activities, practices, or experiences aimed at deepening one's connection with their spiritual beliefs, values, or higher power with the aim of to foster personal growth, inner peace, and a sense of purpose by engaging in introspective and contemplative practices. Moreover it consisted of meditation, prayer, reflection, and discussions on topics related to spirituality and personal development.

The Computer Science Department organized a three-day retreat cum EVS field trip to Bunkulung, Mirik, from September 27th to September 29th, 2022, with 135 students and 5 faculty members in attendance.

Field Work/Trip

#### **EVS Field Trip:**

The EVS field trip kicked off on September 27th, 2022, lasting until September 29th, 2022, during which students participated in planting 75 tree saplings in the Bunkulung forest area, provided by the forest department. Following the tree planting activity, a survey was conducted to assess environmental issues in and around Bunkulung. Over the course of the three-day event, students also engaged in cleaning the area and constructing eco bricks from non-degradable waste materials. They shared the process with neighbouring villages to promote environmentally friendly methods of waste reuse.



#### Department of Sociology

From April 1st to April 9th, 2023, 63 students from the Department of Sociology engaged in a comprehensive household census, conducted in-depth interviews with selected individuals, carried out observations, processed and analysed data, and wrote reports. Through this hands-on experience, students gained valuable insights into the research process, including making scientific observations, building rapport with respondents, conducting interviews, and analysing data using tables and charts. Moreover, they had the unique opportunity to immerse themselves in various aspects of people's lives, including their daily activities, culture, religious practices, and life cycle rituals.

#### **Dept of Geography**

Miss Parvati Rai and Miss Evelyn Lepcha, along with 46 students from the 6th Semester, conducted a survey of the flood-affected area of Shanti Para Village in Guwahati from May 8th to May 13th, 2022. Employing the questionnaire and personal interview method, they aimed to understand the causes and effects of the annual flooding of the Brahmaputra River. In total, 100 households were surveyed as part of this endeavour.

Miss Parvati Rai and Miss Evelyn Lepcha led 45 students from the 4th Semester on a trip to Rumtek, Gangtok, East Sikkim, from April 15th to April 19th, 2022. During their visit, they engaged in a study aimed at comprehending the social and cultural dynamics of the region through the utilization of questionnaires and personal interviews. A total of 100 households were surveyed by the students. This field study provided insights into the social and economic landscape of the rural area, offering students the chance to conduct surveys and interact with local villagers.

#### Dept of Zoology

Ms. Albina Subba and Mr. Shuvam Sharma accompanied 33 students from the Department of Zoology visited Jaldapara National Park spanning from November 4th to November 6th, 2022. During their excursion, they also visited the Buxa Tiger Reserve Museum and embarked on a trek to Buxa Fort. The museum featured a captivating historical narrative and an impressive collection of preserved animals. The day wrapped up with an exhilarating trek to the renowned Buxa Fort.



On the occasion of "World Wildlife Day" a Bird Watching Activity was held at Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park on March 2nd, 2023. Ten students, accompanied by one teacher, took part in the event. Participants, including students and volunteers, were organized into three birding groups and accompanied by bird guides on nature walks.
